News from MU South Sudan emergency relief fund Appeal: An initial grant of £10,500 from the Mothers' Union Relief Fund has been sent to Madi & West Nile in Uganda for the South Sudanese refugee crisis. The money will be specifically used to train Psychosocial Support Workers who will work with those refugees suffering from trauma. We are currently awaiting other surrounding dioceses to inform us of the needs in their areas in order for our relief efforts to be mobilised in the most efficient ways. In South Sudan, Mothers' Union recently visited Unity State to assess the famine situation there and relief funds will support the food needs of families and children facing famine. We are currently in the process of contacting Rev Alice our CDC on the South Sudanese border so we can get more information on how our relief is helping on the ground - we will update again once we have more
