Dear friends, just a very brief note to let you know that it was announced yesterday that I have been appointed as Vicar of St Stephen's Steeton in the Diocese of Leeds. The move was in some sense unexpected, but allows us to be much closer to our daughters and my brother and sister-in-law and nephews , all of whom live in the north of England now, and some of whom need our direct support and closer presence. A date for the induction and installation in the autumn will be confirmed but my likely last Sunday in West Chilt will be 15th September.
